Positive Trends are: Brimfield maintained a rating of Very High in both English and Math as measured by the CPI (Composite Performance Index). Data reveals that Brimfield Elementary provides a "value added" experience for students.

Improvement Opportunities: Brimfield will continue to develop common assessments, as well as practice reviewing student work to ensure reliability among the classroom teachers.

There will be ongoing work between teachers, building principal and the Superintendent to identify and implement strategies that will support closing the achievement gap for identified groups of students.
