

Tantasqua Regional High School is now enrolling candidates interested in becoming an EMT (Emergency Medical Technician). The EMT-Basic course is an accredited didactic/practical program that qualifies successful candidates to take the Commonwealth of Massachusetts EMT Basic Certification Practical and Written Exam.

Classes will be held at Tantasqua Regional High School on Monday/Wednesday evenings and Saturday days beginning on February 3 and running through May 4, 2020. The tuition for this program is \$925. Students will also be responsible for the purchase of the textbook and exam fees..

Candidates must meet the following requirements:

- The ability to read, understand, and communicate in English
- Be 18 years of age or older at the time of exam
- Be free of addiction to alcohol or any drug
- Be able to lift and carry 125 pounds
- Be free of any physical or mental defect or disease which might impair his/her ability to provide emergency care within the scope of the EMT's training and responsibilities, or which might jeopardize the health of another member of the class.
