

Scheduling A Road Test

A [road test](#) can be scheduled by a [customer](#) if the date and time requested by the customer is not already booked for that location.

If the customer is under 18 years of age, he/she must complete a six month period with a clean [driving record](#) on or before the date the road test is scheduled.

A customer under 18 years of age will not be allowed to take the road test when scheduled if the [Registry of Motor Vehicles](#) receives notice of an event that would cause the six month (184 days) clean driving period to be interrupted between the date the test was booked and the date of the test itself.

If the Registry of Motor Vehicles learns of a subsequent citation or surchargeable event after a customer less than 18 years of age has taken and passed a road test, a permanent [license](#) will not be issued to the customer.

A customer is allowed to take a maximum of six [Class D](#) road tests in a 12 month period. For [Class M](#), if a customer fails two road tests, he/she must enroll in and successfully complete a Motorcycle Safety Foundation Basic Rider Course in order to obtain a [Class M license](#).
