Grade 11-Looking Ahead

The eleventh grade will be an evaluative year. We will be assessing each student's skill ability, likes/dislikes and level of independence. This will provide us with the necessary information for continued career placement planning.

Practical English:

The focus is to encourage students to engage in conversations, appropriate questions, comments and approach. Students will continue to review previously learned vocabulary as well as being exposed to new vocabulary based on "real life" and job skills. Comprehension of material and/or daily routines will be stressed.

Practical Math:

The focus is to use math in their everyday living through time awareness/management, money skills, number sense, numerical order, etc. Students will practice using these skills in a variety of situations to strengthen their ability to generalize skills learned.

Team Building:

The focus is to work as a "team" during fitness and recreational activities, as well as increase confidence and independence in specific team roles. Each student is expected to progress at his/her own level of ability.

Job Skills:

The focus is to develop pre-vocational skills on a variety of tasks. Students will be assessed on entry level tasks such as general sorting, cleaning, office tasks, using classroom and office tools, mail sorting, preparation and organizing, etc. Students will be exposed to a variety of work experiences beginning with jobs that are done in the context of the high school. Later in the year, students will be exposed to community job sites and tasks.
