Grade 12-Real World Exploration

In the twelfth grade, students will be exposed to a variety of vocational opportunities. We will be assessing each student's skill ability, likes/dislikes and level of independence. This will provide us with the necessary information for continued career placement planning.

Practical English II:

The focus will be to continue to review previously learned vocabulary as well as being exposed to new vocabulary based on "real life" and specific job skills vocabulary. Students will read and interpret informative texts (newspapers, phonebooks, store directories, etc.) to gather information.

Practical Math II:

The focus is to use math in their everyday living through time awareness/management, money skills, number sense, numerical order, etc. Students will be introduced to the relationship between work, time and money.

Team Building II:

The focus is to work as a "team" during fitness and recreational activities, as well as increase confidence and independence in specific team roles. Each student is expected to progress at his/her own level of ability. Each student will participate in an adapted physical education class, as well as, participate in frequent exercise routines.

Job Skills II:

The focus is to continue to develop pre-vocational skills on a variety of tasks of student's interests and ability. Students will continue to work at tasks such as general sorting, cleaning, office tasks, using classroom and office tools, mail sorting, preparation and organizing, etc. As part of job training, students will learn to cope and/or handle related issues that may arise (i.e. calling in sick, being punctual, personal hygiene, transportation, etc.) Students will go on community trips to generalize skills learned.
